Saints, according to the Biblical definition—not the Church of Rome's definition, particularly in these last days of earth's history and closing hours of mankind's probation, were shown to John the beloved by Christ Himself where the former was banished by the cruel Roman emperor Domitian on the bleak Island of Patmos. John described them as: "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus." Revelation 14: 12, Authorized Version.

INTOLERANCE AND PERSECUTION

The worst and most diabolical forms and implements of torture ever invented by the corrupted human minds, while blasphemously invoking the sacred and holy names and titles exclusively belonging to Almighty God the Father in heaven, ty were introduced during the darkest period of human, the earth, and church's history. Jesus forewarned His first disciples of this terrible period in His mini apocalypse and dual-application prophecies recorded by Matthew and partially

by Luke (who also wrote the book of Acts). Christ's reply was to answer two-part question asked by the anxious disciples as they sat on the top of Mount Olives viewing their beloved but doomed temple and its buildings that He had departed from for the very last time. The disciples' follow-up question when He told them the terrible dual application prophecy they could hardly accept: that "that there shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down." Matt. 24: 2. They, as with the whole Jewish nation believed their temple was indestructible and impregnable; many worshipped it as an idol, choosing it over Jesus Himself, the promised Messiah. Their question was framed in this setting:

"And as He sat upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples came unto Him privately [in secret], saying, Tell us, *when* shall these things be? And *what* shall be the sign of Thy *coming*, and the *end* of the world?" v. 3.

Jesus cited a list of things that would take place shortly as well centuries later, one of which was:

"And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days? But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the Sabbath day: For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days be should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened." vs. 19-22. (emphasis mine)

The "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be" that was mercifully "shortened" "for the elect's sake, lest "no flesh be saved" was the Dark Ages that was 1260 day-year prophecy.

The messenger-prophet of God for these last days wrote:

"The scriptural ordinance of the Lord's supper has been supplanted by the idolatrous sacrifice of the mass. Papal priests pretended, by their senseless mummery, to convert the simple bread and wine into the actual 'body and blood of Christ.' – *Cardinal Wiseman's Lectures on 'The Real Presence,' Lecture 8, par.*26. With blasphemous presumption, they openly claimed the power of creating *God, the Creator of all things.* [the Papal doctrine of "transubstantiation."] Christians were required, on pain of death, to avow their faith in this horrible, Heaven-insulting heresy. Multitudes who refused were *given to the flames*.

[Appendix Note: PURGATORY. – Dr. Joseph Faa Di Bruno thus defines purgatory: 'Purgatory is a state of suffering *after* this life, in which those souls are for a time detained, who depart this life after their deadly sins have been remitted as to the stain and guilt, and as to the everlasting pain that was due to them; but who have on account of those sins still some debt of temporal punishment to pay; as also those souls which leave this world guilty of venial sins.' –'Catholic Belief,' page 196 (ed. 1884: imprimatur Archbishop of New York).' p. 681 *General Notes*.

"In the thirteenth century was established the most terrible of all the engines of the papacy---**the Inquisition**. The prince of darkness wrought with the leaders of the papal hierarchy. In their secret councils, Satan and his angels

controlled the minds of evil men, while unseen in the midst stood and angel of God, taking the fearful record of their iniquitous decrees, and writing the history of deeds too horrible to appear to human eyes. 'Babylon the great' was 'drunken with the blood of the saints.' The mangled forms of millions of martyrs cried to God for vengeance upon that apostate power.

"Popery had become the world's despot. Kings and emperors bowed to the decrees of the Roman pontiff. The destinies of men, both for time and for eternity, seemed under his control. For hundreds of years the doctrines of Rome had been extensively and implicitly received, its rites reverently performed, its festivals generally observed. Its clergy were honored and liberally sustained. Never since has the Roman Church attained to greater dignity, magnificence, or power.

"But 'the noon of the papacy was the midnight of the world.' (Wylie, 'History of Protestantism,' book 1 chap. 4). The Holy Scriptures were almost unknown, not only to the people, but to the priests. Like the Pharisees of old, the papal leaders hated the light which would reveal their sins. God's law, the standard of righteousness, having been removed, they exercised power without limit, and practiced vice, without restraint. Fraud, avarice, and profligacy prevailed. Men shrank from no crime by which they could gain wealth or position. The palaces of popes and prelates were scenes of the vilest debauchery. Some of the reigning pontiffs were guilty of crimes so revolting that secular rulers endeavored to depose these dignitaries of the church as monsters too vile to be tolerated. For centuries Europe [the Old World] had made no progress in learning, arts, or civilization. A moral and intellectual paralysis had fallen upon Christendom.

"The condition of the world under the Romish power presented a fearful and striking fulfillment of the words of the prophet Hosea: 'My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.' Hosea 4; 6, 1, 2. 'There is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. By swearing, and lying, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood.'- *Ibid*. Such were the *results of banishing the word of God.*" – *Ellen G. White, Great Controversy, 1911 ed., pp. 59, 60, Pacific Press Publishing Asso. Mt. View, CA*.

The Office of Inquisition was not merely "Spanish," as is erroneously repeated and perpetuated but is the Roman Church's creation fear to those who opposed her false doctrines and usurped divine authority by claiming to be the "Vicar of Christ"—instead of the Holy Spirit, the third Person of the Godhead, whom Christ Himself introduced and promised His disciples prior to His death and ascension as recorded in John chapters 14 and 16, as well as claiming to be "verily God on earth."! The purpose and function of the Office of the Inquisition remain unchanged throughout its dark history since its inception even as the Church of Rome and its hierarchy—the papacy, and its fundamental antichristian doctrines and decretals remain unchanged, as prophecy long revealed to the Christian

AIMS OF THE PAPACY FOR AMERICA & THE WORLD

GC 563-5:

"Romanism is now regarded by Protestants with far greater favor than in former years. (See above on American Anti-Catholicism]. In those countries where Catholicism is not in the ascendancy [yet], and the papists are taking a [supposedly] conciliatory course in order to gain influence, there is an increasing indifference concerning the doctrines that separate the reformed churches from the papal hierarchy; the opinion is gaining ground, that, after all, we do not differ so widely upon vital points as has been supposed, and that *a little concession on our part* will bring us into a better understanding with Rome.

"The time was when Protestants placed a high value upon the *liberty of conscience* which had been so dearly purchased. They taught their children to abhor popery [ant it certainly was not because of prejudice or "anti-Catholicism" as you very well can see by now], and held that to seek harmony with Rome would be disloyalty to God. But how widely different are the sentiments now expressed [Note: this edition was published in 1911, and its original edition was in 1884!].

"The defenders of the papacy declare that the church has been maligned [??]; and that the Protestant world are inclined to accept the statement. Many urge that it is unjust to judge the church of to-day by the abominations and absurdities that marked her reign during the centuries of ignorance and darkness. They [the horribly persecuted churches!] excuse her horrible cruelty [as the Vicar of Christ?] as a result of the barbarity of the times, and plead that the influences of modern civilization has changed her sentiments.

"Have these persons forgotten **the claim of infallibility** put forth for *eight* hundred years by this haughty power? So far from being relinquished, this claim was affirmed in the nineteenth century with greater positiveness than ever before. As Rome asserts that the church 'never erred;' nor will it, according to the Scriptures, ever err,' how can she renounce the principles which governed her course in past ages? (quoted from Mosheim, "Ecclesiastical History,' book 3, cent. 11, part 2, ch. 2, par. 9, note 1).

"The papal church will *never relinquish her claims to infallibility*. All that she has done in her persecution of those who reject her dogmas, she holds to be right; and would she not repeat the same acts, should the opportunity be presented? Let the restraints now imposed by secular governments be removed [ideally and specifically the First Amendment of the Bill of Rights of the U.S. Constitution], and Rome be reinstated in her former power, and there would speedily be a revival of her tyranny and persecution.

Watch out for Papal Encyclical Letters of Past, Present, and Future!

"A well-known writer [Dr. Josiah Strong] speaks thus of the attitude of the papal hierarchy [the Holy See] as regards *freedom of conscience*, *and of the perils which especially threaten the United States from the success of her* policy:

"There are many who are disposed to attribute any fear of Roman Catholicism in the United States to bigotry or childishness. Such see nothing in the character and attitude of Romanism that is hostile to our free institutions [specifically civil and religious liberties] or find nothing portentous in its growth. Let us, then first compare some of the fundamental principles of our government with those of the Catholic Church.

"'The Constitution of the United States guarantees *liberty of conscience*. Nothing is dearer or more fundamental. Pope Pius VI., in his Encyclical Letter of Aug. 15, 1854, said: 'The absurd and erroneous doctrines or ravings in defense of liberty of conscience, are a most pestilential error--- a pest, of all others, most to be dreaded in a state.' The same pope, in his Encyclical Letter of December 8, 1864, anathemized 'those who assert the liberty of conscience and of religious worship,' also 'all such as maintain that the church may not employ *force*.'

"The pacific tone of Rome in the United States does *not* imply a change of heart. *She is tolerant where she is helpless*. Says Bishop O'Connor: 'Religious liberty is merely endured until the opposite can be carried into effect without peril to the Catholic world.'... The archbishop of St. Louis once said: 'Heresy and unbelief are crimes; and in Christian countries, as in Italy and Spain, fro instance, [such are *Roman*, not Christian in substance, doctrine, and practice-Christian meaning, Christ-like] religion is an essential part of the law of the land, and they are *punished as other crimes*."....

"'Every cardinal, archbishop, and bishop in the Catholic Church takes and oath of allegiance to the pope [not Christ!], in which occur the following words: 'Heretics, schismatics, and rebels to our said Lord (the pope), or his aforesaid successors, I will to my utmost persecute and oppose." (*Strong, Dr. Josiah, 'Our Country,*" ch. 5, pars. 1-3).

"It is true there are real Christians in the Roman Catholic communion. Thousands in that church are serving God according to the best light they have. They are not allowed access to His word, and therefore they do not discern the truth. They have never seen the contrast between the living heart-service and a round of mere forms and ceremonies. *God looks with pitying tenderness upon these souls*, educated as they are in a faith that is delusive and unsatisfying. He will cause rays of light to penetrate the dense darkness that surrounds them. He will reveal to them *the truth as it is in Jesus*, and many will yet take their position with His people.

"But Romanism as a system is no more in harmony with the gospel of Christ now than at any former period in her history. The Protestant churches are in great darkness, or they would discern the signs of the times. The Roman Church is far-reaching in her plans and modes of operation. She is employing every device to extend her influence and increase her power in preparation for a fierce and determined conflict to regain control of the world, to re-establish persecution, and to undo all that Protestantism has done. Catholicism is gaining ground on every side. See the increasing number of her churches and chapels in Protestant countries [particularly America]. Look at the popularity of her colleges [and universities] and seminaries in America, so widely patronized by Protestants. Look at the growth of ritualism in England, and the frequent defections to the ranks of the Catholics. These things should awaken the anxiety of all who prize the pure principles of the gospel.

"Protestants have tampered with and patronized popery; they have made compromises and concessions which papists themselves are surprised to see, and fail to understand [because they do not understand the special prophecies of Revelation 13 regarding who "the beast with lamblike horns is initially, that will transform into "one speaking like a dragon," as "the image to or of the beast" who will enact and enforce "the mark of the beast"!] Men are closing their eyes to the re4al character of Romanism, and the dangers to be apprehended from her supremacy. The people need to be aroused to resist the advances of this most dangerous foe to civil and religious liberty."

NOTE: From these clear Biblical, historical, and secular truths and revelations, it becomes quite evident today that the current national hysteria and anxiety over the influx/immigration of Muslims and Islam into the U.S. and the specter of "sharia law" being adopted in certain states is, in reality, a skillfully-crafted and carefully-orchestrated fear-mongering campaign, a giant smokescreen to distract the attention of the once-Protestant America from what the founding Fathers knew and warned of as the real enemy of Americanism and its twin fundamental foundations and secrets of its peace and prosperity---civil and religious liberties! Hence, "Eternal vigilance is the price of liberty, etc.!

"Many Protestants suppose that the Catholic religion is unattractive, and that its worship is a dull, meaningless round of ceremony. Here they mistake. While Romanism is based upon deception, it is not a coarse and clumsy imposture. The religious service of the Roman Church is a most impressive ceremonial. *Its gorgeous display and solemn rites fascinate the senses of the people, and silence the voice of reason and of conscience*. The eye is charmed. Magnificent churches, imposing processions, golden altars, jeweled shrines, choice paintings, and exquisite sculpture appeal to the love of [temporal] beauty. [the "church of the poor" as Pope Francis recently described?!]. the ear is captivated. The music is unsurpassed. The rich notes of the deep-toned organ, blending with the melody of many voices as it swells through the lofty domes and pillared aisles of her

grand cathedrals, cannot fail to impress the mind with awe and reverence. [Ah! so well described!]

"This *outward* splendor, pomp, and ceremony, that only mocks the longings of the sin-sick soul, is an evidence of *inward* corruption. **The religion of Christ needs not such attractions to recommend it**. In the light shining from the cross, true Christianity appears so pure and lovely that no external decorations can enhance its true worth. It is the beauty of holiness, a meek and quiet spirit, which is of value to God.

"Brilliancy of style is not necessarily and index of pure, elevated thought. High conceptions of art, delicate refinement of taste, often exist in minds that are earthly and sensual. They are often employed by Satan to lead men to forget the necessities of the soul, to lose sight of the future, immortal life, to turn away from their infinite Helper, and to live for this world alone.

"The religion of externals is attractive to the unrenewed heart. The pomp and ceremony of the Catholic worship has a seductive, bewitching power, by which many are deceived; and they come to look upon the Roman Church as the very gate of heaven. None but those who have planted their feet firmly upon the foundation of truth, and whose hearts are renewed by the Spirit of God, are proof against her influence. Thousands who have not an experimental knowledge of Christ will be led to accept the forms of godliness without the power []. Such a religion is just what the multitudes desire. [This is the religion that Marx and Engels, founders of atheistic socialism and communism referred to as "religion being the opium of the masses," and not simple, pure Christianity that Christ, as its Cornerstone and Foundation, and His apostles established].

"The Church's claim to the right to pardon, leads the Romanist to feel at liberty to sin; and the ordinance of confession, without which her pardon is not granted, tends also to give license to evil. He who kneels before fallen man, and opens in confession the secret thoughts and imaginations of his heart, is debasing his manhood, and degrading every noble instinct of his soul. In unfolding the sins of his life to the priest,--an erring, sinful mortal, and too often corrupted with wine and licentiousness, ---his standard of character is lowered, and he is defiled in consequence. His thought of God is degraded to the likeness of fallen humanity; for the priest stands as a representative of God. This degrading confession of man to man is the secret spring from which has flowed much of the evil that is defiling the world, and fitting it for the final destruction.

"Yet to him who loves self-indulgence, it is more pleasing to confess to a fellow-mortal than to open the soul to God. It is more palatable to human nature to do penance than to renounce sin; it is easier to mortify the flesh by sackcloth and nettles and galling chains than to crucify fleshly lusts. Heavy is the yoke which the carnal heart is willing to bear rather than bow to the yoke of Christ. [This is the real, contemptible "righteousness by works,"!] "- *Ibid*, pp. 563-568.
